

Laney Summer Music 2017

Laney College Music Department is part of Peralta's High School, Middle School, and Elementary School Special Enrollment program. The Summer Music Program provides enrichment opportunities for these students, who benefit from college level instruction.

Admission to the Summer Music Program must be with the recommendation of the school counselor and principal.

Students enrolling in this college level course must follow all the regulations and policies of the college.

Students are exempted from paying the California Community College enrollment fees but are asked for a donation of \$125.00 for each two week session to support the cost of special music counselors, coaches, and conductors.

Enrollment is divided into two age groups. Students 13 and over as of the first day of the program, June 19th, 2017, will use the method described in the section below labeled **13 and older**.

Students 13 and under as of the first day of the program, June 19th, 2017, will use the method described in the section below labeled **13 and younger**.

STEPS FOR STUDENTS 13 AND OLDER:
